1. Booking & Arrival to the golf course

To access the course, a player must:

- Not be displaying any COVID-19 symptoms.

If you, or any member of your household has come into contact with a suspected case of COVID 19, you should self-isolate and not attend the golf club for a minimum of 14 days.

- Have a pre-reserved tee time.
- Respect social distancing at all times.
- The use of the face mask is mandatory all time except when playing golf on the course or when practicing on the practice areas on an individual basis or with your family members or when consuming drinks and/or food at the bar and restaurant.
- Store and clean golf equipment at home.



2. Check-in & Club Facilities

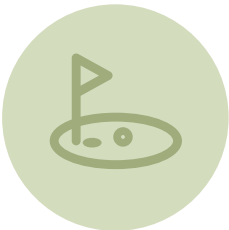
- Pro shop, changing rooms, lockers, club storage rooms and toilets are open.
- It is recommended to pay by credit card.
- Pro shop counter equipped with protection screens.
- Score cards also downloadable from club's website.
- Toilets will have open entrance doors and are cleaned regularly.
- Automatic disinfection gel dispensers located at the entrance to the clubhouse and by the toilets. Disposable paper towels provided.

- Bar open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday from 09:00 a 17:00h. Closed Thursday and Saturday.
- Beverage and snacks can be purchased in the pro shop. Buggy bar available on the course.
- Buggies are sanitized before and after usage. Shared buggies but wearing a mask. The driver must be the same person during the round.
- Please pick up your buggy 10 minutes before your tee off time.
- Ball and club cleaners disabled in the buggies. Personal bunker rake provided in each buggy.



3. Before going to the 1st tee

- Driving range, putting green and short game area are open.
- Players practicing must observe physical distancing.
- Arrive at the 1st tee no more than 5 minutes prior to the reserved tee time.



4. On the Course

- Respect the physical distancing throughout the round.
- Do not touch flagsticks, hazard stakes, distance markers, tee logs or any other course aid. Contact-free ball retrieval system available on each hole to lift the ball with the club.
- Broken tee caddies, bunker rakes, benches and tee divot boxes have been removed.

- Par 3 holes & hole # 4 are compulsory call up holes to avoid player congestion.
- Play ready golf. Do not allow the group behind to go through.
- Players must not pick up another player's golf ball or equipment. Food, drink or equipment cannot be exchanged between players.
- Players must refrain from handshakes and high fives.
- All golfers must come in from the course 30 minutes prior to course closing time.
- It is forbidden to purchase balls from the ball sellers.



5. Getting Home Safely

- Post-round players must take their own waste from the buggies.
- Ensure clubs and equipment are cleaned thoroughly after use at home.
- Players must call or email the golf club with any post-round health issues or COVID-19 related queries, at the earliest opportunity.
